SMBC have announced the revised date for the extraordinary meeting of the Bramhall and Cheadle Hulme South Area Committee as **Thursday, 17<sup>th</sup> July 2014 at 6.30pm in the Centrepoint Hall, Bramhall Methodist Church**. This meeting has been convened specifically to consider the development application for the former BAe Woodford site.
