

A6 to Manchester Airport Relief Road

Dear Sir/Madam,

Notification of Excavation Works at the A555 Roundabout near Woodford Road, Bramhall, Stockport

We write to inform you that the appointed contractor for the A6 to Manchester Airport Relief Road (A6 MARR), Carillion Morgan Sindall (CMS) will be entering the next phase of works, which will involve the construction of our temporary diversion works at Woodford Road, Bramhall, leading onto the A555.

From week commencing 14/09/2015, we will begin to strip vegetation and remove top soil for the new road alignment. Bulk excavation will then follow on the new on and off-slip roads from the A555. A new temporary roundabout will be constructed on the A555, before the existing A555/Woodford Road roundabout, which will facilitate our bridge works at the same location. The works are expected to be completed by autumn 2017.

Woodford Road, Bramhall will remain open throughout the works. The new, temporary roundabout will permit the same vehicle movements as the existing roundabout, with access to and exit from the A555 maintained throughout the works.

This work will be carried out during our day time working hours of 7am until 6pm Mondays to Fridays.

CMS have liaised with Stockport Metropolitan Borough Council to put all the appropriate consents in place.
