

Public meeting re findings of Design Workshop on the future of Woodford! Over 30 members of the public took part in a "Design Workshop" exercise last month to help determine how the local communities would like to see Woodford airfield develop now that BAE are closing down their operations. Those taking part were from various backgrounds, some being local councillors, some being from the planning profession, but with most being ordinary members of the public. The exercise was spread over several days and was guided by Handforth based Taylor Young, a firm that specializes in town planning and urban design. The findings of the workshop are to be presented on *Thursday 14th July at 6.30pm (Woodford Community Centre)*. <u>All members of the public are invited</u>. Whilst it is highly unlikely that this will be the occasion for the unveiling of a masterplan concerning the airfield's future, nevertheless it should be possible to get a clearer picture of the options available and the general principles to be followed. If you are at all interested in how Woodford develops, or in how the communities surrounding Woodford are to be affected, then please come along.
