Public exhibition starts next week! BAe are holding an exhibition concerning the redevelopment of Woodford airfield, with the aim of gathering the views of local residents. This is a major redevelopment potentially involving the building of hundreds of new houses, commercial development, and the construction of new roads and bypasses. As such, it is of key interest not only to people in Woodford but also to people living in Bramhall, Poynton, Adlington and even outlying districts such as Pott Shrigley and Mottram.

According to the BAe blurb, “Woodford aerodrome presents an exciting opportunity to consider how the site is regenerated” with responses from the exhibition being fed into the planning processes of both Stockport and Cheshire East councils.
